

RESOLUTION 2007-20

**AN AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION 2005-23 ADOPTED ON SEPTEMBER 13, 2005
AUTHORIZING A RECYCLING ADVISORY COMMITTEE
FOR THE TOWN OF SILVER CITY**

WHEREAS, It has been determined by the Town of Silver City that it is in the best interest of our citizens to continue recycling efforts in the most efficient, effective and optimal manner possible; and

WHEREAS, The Town understands its responsibility to make every effort possible to preserve our environment, protect our natural resources and provide a safe place for our citizens to work and play; and

WHEREAS, The Town's current contract with the Southwest Solid Waste Authority for recycling no longer provides for a Recycling Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Town acknowledges the importance of obtaining community participation in determining what efforts the Town will make towards recycling.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Silver City that:

1. A Recycling Advisory Committee be formed consisting of seven (7) people acting in a voluntary capacity. At least five (5) of the volunteers shall be Silver City residents or owners of businesses located in Silver City.
2. The Committee members will be appointed by the Mayor, with consensus of the Council. A Committee chairperson will be chosen by the Committee members at their initial meeting. The chairperson will also serve as a liaison between the Town Staff, the Southwest Solid Waste Authority and the public.
3. The Committee will advise the Town Council on all aspects of recycling, including but not limited to:
 - A. evaluating and enhancing recycling operations;
 - B. developing and implementing promotional and educational programs;
 - C. serving as a source for ideas, new concepts, suggestions and innovations in the field of recycling;
 - D. review of the operating plan and contract between the Town and the Southwest Solid Waste Authority evaluating residential and commercial recycling services and processing center operation, collection operation and marketing plans.
