

INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES

If you plan to run for office, **Candidate Information Packets** will be available in the Town Clerk's Office beginning November 29, 2017.

Packet information will also be available on the Town's website, www.townofsilvercity.org.

Candidates file for elective office at the office of the Municipal Clerk on January 9, 2018, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. The form for the declaration of candidacy is in the Candidate Information Packet.

Absentee / Early Voting Info

Contact the Municipal Clerk at 534-6346, townclerk@silvercitynm.gov, or stop by City Hall at 101 West Broadway to obtain an application for an absentee ballot. Absentee ballots may be issued/mailed to voters, whose applications have been approved, beginning January 30 to March 2, 2018. No absentee ballot shall be delivered or mailed to any person other than the applicant for such ballot. Early voting in person at City Hall on paper ballots counted by the Dominion electronic vote tabulator begins on February 14, 2018 and ends at 5:00 p.m. on March 2, 2018.

IMPORTANT VOTER INFORMATION

To vote in the March 6, 2018 Municipal Election, you must be registered by 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, February 6, 2018. Please contact the **Grant County Clerk's Office** at **574-0042**

to register to vote or update your voter registration information (name change, address change, etc.)

Note: Please check the Council district map at City Hall or the Town's website to confirm your district.

Absentee Voting

To vote Absentee by paper ballot, call the Town Clerk's Office at 534-6346 and request an "Application for an Absent Voter Ballot". The Application must be filled out

and received by the Town Clerk's Office by 5:00 p.m., Friday, March 2, 2018. Absentee Ballots may be returned by mail or in person. If returned in person the Absentee Ballot can only be accepted from the person who voted, their immediate family, or caregiver. All ballots, whether mailed or delivered in person, must be received by the Town Clerk's Office by 7:00 p.m. Tuesday, March 6, 2018 (Election Day).

Early Voting (in person, using voting machine)

The Town Clerk's Office will serve as the only polling location for Early Voting by paper ballot counted by the Dominion electronic vote tabulator, beginning Wed., Feb. 14, 2018 and ending Friday, March 2, 2018. The Town Clerk's Office is located in City Hall, 101 West Broadway.

POLLING PLACE

Voters from District 1, 2, 3 and 4 may vote at the Voting Convenience Center at the Silver City Woman's Club, 411 Silver Heights Blvd., Silver City, NM.

District 1 (full and partial County Precincts 13, 14, and 15 within the Town limits)

District 2 (full and partial County Precincts 12, 13, 15, 18, 19, and 20 within the Town limits)

District 3 (full and partial County Precincts 8, 11, 17, 20, 21, 22, 32, and 33 within the Town limits)

District 4 (full and partial County Precincts 14, 16, 19, and 32 within the Town limits)
