

**RESOLUTION 2007-28**  
**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE IMPLEMENTATION**  
**OF A NOISE ORDINANCE ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

**INTRODUCED BY COUNCILOR A. JUDITH WARD**

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined by the Town of Silver City that it is in the best interest of our citizens to develop a more comprehensive and enforceable Noise Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town realizes the impact noise has on the quality of life of the residents of Silver City; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to weigh the rights of citizens to create noise in their daily lives against the right of citizens to live without noise interfering with the enjoyment of their quality of life; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town currently has a noise ordinance that is vague and difficult to enforce; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town acknowledges the importance of obtaining community participation in creating a new comprehensive and enforceable Noise Ordinance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Town of Silver Council that:

1. A Noise Ordinance Advisory Committee be formed consisting of seven (7) people acting in a voluntary capacity. At least one shall be from each voting district of the Town, and the remaining three may be selected from any district.
2. The Committee members will be appointed by the Mayor, with consensus of the Council. A Committee chairperson will be chosen by the Committee members at their initial meeting. The chairperson will also serve as a liaison with Town Staff.
3. The Committee will make recommendations to the Town Council on all aspects in the development of a comprehensive and enforceable Noise Ordinance.
