

INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES

If you plan to run for office, **Candidate Information Packets** will be available in the Municipal Clerk's Office beginning Monday, December 1, 2008.

Packets will also be available on the Town's website, www.townofsilvercity.org.

Candidates file for office on January 6, 2009, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

This is the ONLY time to declare for office !

If you plan to vote by **Absentee Paper Ballot**, you must request an application from the Municipal Clerk's Office. An application may be requested by the voter in person, or by telephone, e-mail or mail beginning on January 27, 2009. Any voter may request an application for an Absentee Ballot for an immediate family member (spouse, children, parents, brothers and sisters). To vote in the March 3, 2009 Municipal Election, you must be registered by 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, February 3, 2009. Please contact the **Grant County Clerk's Office at 574-0042**

to register to vote or update your voter registration information.

Note: *If you have recently moved to another district within the Town, in order to vote in the correct district, you must update your voter registration.*

Absentee Voting (by mail)

To vote Absentee by paper ballot, call the Municipal Clerk's Office at 534-6346 and request an "Application for an

Absent Voter Ballot" beginning on January 27, 2009. The Application must be filled out and received by the Municipal Clerk's Office by 5:00 p.m., Friday, February 27, 2009. Absentee Ballots may be returned by mail or in person. If returned in person the Absentee Ballot can only be accepted from the person who voted, or their immediate family. All ballots, whether mailed or delivered in person, must be received by the Municipal Clerk's Office by 7:00 p.m. Tuesday, March 3, 2009 (Election Day).

Absentee Voting (in person)

The Municipal Clerk's Office will serve as the only polling location for Absentee voting by paper ballot, beginning Wednesday, February 4 and ending Friday, February 27. The Municipal Clerk's Office is located in City Hall, 101 West Broadway.
