Approval of Minutes - Regular Meeting, July 26, 2011

Public Hearings:

A. Approval / Disapproval of Resolution No. 2011-27, a request for an Encroachment Permit to allow designated parking spaces that encroach into the East 13th Street right-of-way. The property is described as the West 10 feet of Lots 1, 3, 5 and 7, and All of Lots 2, 4, 6, 8, Block 254 of Fraser's Survey of the Townsite of Silver City, and is addressed as 501 East 13th Street. The applicant is The Volunteer Center of Grant County.

B. Approval / Disapproval of Appeal #AP 11-01: an Appeal of the Planning and Zoning Commission's decision to approve a Variance to allow and 1800 sq ft accessory building where the maximum allowable is 875 sq ft. The owner of the property is John Callahan and the appellant is Thomas Nupp.
