Public Hearings:

A. Approval/Disapproval of Ordinance No. 1199: A Zone Change request for a parcel addressed as 1412 N. Bennett Street, Silver City, NM. The request is to amend the Official Zoning Map for that property described as Lots 6 and 8, Block 267 of the Fraser Addition from Commercial District to Mixed-use District. The applicant is Darlene Dawn Gray.

B. Approval/Disapproval of Ordinance No. 1200: A request for a Map Amendment/Zone Change for a tract of land addressed as 503 Spring Street, Silver City, NM, which is currently in two zoning districts. The parcel is described as part of Lots 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, and 15, Block 27 of the Fraser Addition. The request is to amend the Official Zoning Map for that portion of the property within the Commercial District to Historic Downtown Commercial District. The applicants are Robert and Marian Reimann.
