**CALL TO ORDER** – Chair Domino-Mrazik called the meeting to order at 1:32 p.m. Carl Scholl was absent (excused).

**CHANGES TO THE AGENDA** – None.

**APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES – February 26, 2014 Regular Meeting** – Chair Domino-Mrazik asked for a motion to approve the minutes. Mr. Fell moved to approve the minutes. Mr. South seconded. All were in favor to approve the minutes. Motion carried.

**PUBLIC INPUT** – None.

**REPORTS -**

**A. Public Works Representative –**

**1. An update on the mural concept and drawing.** Mr. Pena reported that the Town Manager approved the mural concept and agreed with the Cemetery Board that the wall should only have the names of the people that were buried at the Memory Lane Cemetery. He said Diana Leyba-Ingalls said the mural would have to include all of the names of people buried at all of the cemeteries in order for it to be a community project that Comcast would participate in for Comcast Cares Day in April. He provided details of a Comcast community project and how Comcast gave \$100 per volunteer. He said that Ms. Leyba-Ingalls said it was still a good project, and could possibly be done later in the year, but not with Comcast. There was further discussion.

**2. An update on the tree plantings.** Chair Domino-Mrazik asked Mr. Pena about the tree grant. He said he would submit an application for a grant through Apache, and would seek the help of Denise Smith from the Office of Sustainability since she had been successful in the past with tree grants. There was further discussion about whether Freeport McMoRan or Wal-Mart would donate funds for trees. Mr. Pena said he would talk with the Town Manager and Library Director since the Library had recently received a grant from Freeport McMoRan.

Parks Supervisor, Jesus Alvillar, said the trees were blooming and he described how well a super-bloom product worked because trees needed food and water to get more stimulation and to expand out. He said he would inspect the trees and use insecticides if there were any boars. He said that he would know by August or September which trees were strong. There was further discussion about the life span of live oaks and the parking situation near the trees. Mr. Pena said they could use part of the new section for parking if necessary.
