**CALL TO ORDER** – Chair Domino-Mrazik called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

**CHANGES TO THE AGENDA** – None.

**APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES – March 26, 2014 Regular Meeting** – Chair Domino-Mrazik asked for a motion to approve the minutes. Mr. Fell moved to approve the minutes with one correction, that Jose be changed to Jesus for Parks Supervisor under reports, update on the tree plantings. Mrs. Miller seconded. All were in favor to approve the minutes. Motion carried.

**PUBLIC INPUT** – Under public input, Councilor Cano wanted to formally introduce herself to the committee and discussed a little about herself to include her past work experience and education.

**REPORTS -**

**A. Public Works Representative** – Mr. Pena reported that the fiscal year was almost at an end and that there was a small amount of funding left in the Cemetery budget and that he was proposing to use the remainder of the funds to construct concrete walk paths and sidewalks at the cemetery to help with maintenance. He said constructing concrete paths each year would help minimize the area that needs to be maintained by the Parks/Cemetery employees. At the end of each fiscal year, Mr. Pena said he would determine what funding remained in the budget and would construct as much concrete paths and sidewalks as the funding would allow.

**B. Chair -**

**1. Presentation of photos from the Cemetery Crawl event.** Chair Domino-Mrazik passed around the table a collection of photos that were taken during the Cemetery Crawl event at Memory Lane. The collage showed local residents portraying some of the famous people that are buried at the cemetery. Chair Domino-Mrazik said the collage was not complete but as soon as it was done that she would forward it to Ann so it could be posted on the Towns website.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS** - None.

**NEW BUSINESS -**

**A.** Mr. Scholl discussed with the committee the idea of installing historical marked signs in Sections A, B & C in the old section of the cemetery. These signs would commemorate the historical names of the sections as they were named around 1905. Section A-Knights of Pythias (KP), Section B-Independent Order of Odd Fellows (IOOF), and Section C-Ancient Order of United Workmen (AOUW). The committee requested that it be put on the next month's agenda for further discussion.

**B. Schedule the next meeting and discuss agenda items for the next meeting.** The next meeting was scheduled for Wednesday, May 28, 2014.
