

**TOWN OF SILVER CITY RECYCLING ADVISORY COMMITTEE
MEETING MINUTES – NOVEMBER 05, 2015**

Held at Office of Sustainability, Pope St, Silver City, NM

Call to Order: Meeting called to order at 3:00 PM. Members in attendance: Terry Timme, acting chair, Tommy Ogas, Recycling Supervisor, David Krisch, Gordon West and Connie Glenn. Members absent: Alan Archer, Jane Riger and Kelduyn Garland.

Minutes: Minutes from October 01, 2015 were reviewed and approved by voice vote.

Old Business: (Terry Timme)

- Discussion of the small recycle bin distribution. Some bins will be distributed at the Senior Citizens Center and America Recycle Day.
- Walmart received a violation regarding the Plastic Bag Ordinance. Walmart was informed of the warning and the required compliance needed.

New Business: (Terry Timme)

- Discussion on America Recycle Day which will be held on November 14th from 9am – 12pm. Location to be the Office of Sustainability on Pope St. Set up will begin at 8:30am.
- Gordon West commented on composting project and progress thereof. More encouragement will be given to home based composting.
- Fall leaf collection is ongoing at the Volunteer Center and Landfill.

SWSWA Report: (Tommy Ogas)

- Recycle Bins 600 (26 gallon size) have been ordered and shipped. Once received they will be distributed to those already on the waiting list.
- Glass – 22,000 lbs collect in the past month for a grand total of 770,921 lbs collected since 2011.
- Cardboard – 38 bales shipped on 10/28/15
- Single Stream – shipments made on 10/25, 10/26, 10/27 for a total of 81 bales. Currently have 24 bales pending shipment
- E-waste – 24 pallets shipped to Unicor. This is the last shipment to Unicor. CRT's will no longer be recycled, only the power cord from them.

Update from Office of Sustainability: (Terry Timme)

- Terry, Tommy & Carol attended a conference on Illegal Dumping.
- South Central Solid Waste and a local cement manufacture are working on a program for tire recycling.
- Terry and Tommy will be attending a Presentation for Tire Recycling.
- Judge Laney, James Marshall, Gary Stailey, Terry (RAC), Tommy and Dora (SWSWA) are working on a program where the landfill will be host to where DWI individuals can perform their community service in operation of the Habitat Restore section, located next to the Recycling Center.
