

**RESOLUTION NO. 2011-36**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF SILVER CITY, NEW MEXICO, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A NEW MEXICO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION/LOCAL GOVERNMENT DIVISION; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AS THE TOWN OF SILVER CITY'S CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE TO ACT IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE TOWN OF SILVER CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.**

**WHEREAS**, the need exists within the Town of Silver City for housing rehabilitation in several low and moderate income neighborhoods and the Town desires to apply to the Community Development Block Grant Program to obtain funding for housing rehabilitation projects funded through the Housing and Urban Development Block Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, there have been four public meetings held to encourage public input and comment during the 2012 application process; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council finds that there is a significant need to continue its housing rehabilitation program to insure that there is safe and secure housing within the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council determines that the Homeowner Housing Rehabilitation Project meets the requirements of the Community Development Block Grant Program.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Town of Silver City, New Mexico, that:

1. The Town of Silver City is hereby authorized to prepare and submit a Community Development Block Grant application to the New Mexico Department of Finance and Administration/Local Government Division for the purpose of continuing its Housing Rehabilitation Program for low and moderate income residents; and
2. The Town Council directs and designates the Mayor as the Town of Silver City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the Town of Silver City's participation in the New Mexico Community Development Block Grant Program; and
3. The Town of Silver City's officials and staff are directed to conduct any and all acts necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution; and
4. The application be for \$390,000.00 of grant funds to carry out six homeowner occupied rehabilitation projects; and

5. That it further be stated that the Town of Silver City is committing \$39,000.00 as a cash contribution toward the rehabilitation of six homeowner occupied units.
