

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-38

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SILVER CITY, NEW MEXICO, AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR A GRANT TO THE NEW MEXICO RECYCLING COALITION; AND AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO ACT AS THE TOWN OF SILVER CITY'S AUTHORIZED AGENT IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO PARTICIPATION IN THE GRANT.

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Recycling Coalition is soliciting grant proposal applications from public entities for the improvement of existing recycling hub processing facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Silver City is a public entity eligible to apply for this grant; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Silver City supports and encourages recycling; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Silver City contracts recycling services with the Southwest Solid Waste Authority; and

WHEREAS, the proposed grant "Recycling Center Upgrade - Pit Conveyor System" will improve the recycling infrastructure and lead to cost savings;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Town of Silver City endorses and supports an application for the proposed grant, and

Hereby requests that the New Mexico Recycling Coalition consider and approve said application..
