

**RESOLUTION NO. 2011-40**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF SILVER CITY, NEW MEXICO, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A NEW MEXICO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION/LOCAL GOVERNMENT DIVISION; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AS THE TOWN OF SILVER CITY'S CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE TO ACT IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE TOWN OF SILVER CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.**

**WHEREAS**, the need exists within the Town of Silver City for neighborhood improvements projects in several low and moderate income neighborhoods, and the Town of Silver City desires to apply to the Housing and Urban Development's Community Development Block Grant Program to obtain funding for neighborhood improvement projects; and

**WHEREAS**, there have been four public meetings held to encourage public input and comment during the 2012 application process; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council finds that there is a significant need to undertake a Street and Drainage Improvement Project on Alice, Bullard, Garcia and Texas Street in the Chihuahua Hill Neighborhood Area to provide adequate services to the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council determines that the Street and Drainage Improvement Project on Alice, Bullard, Garcia and Texas Street meets the requirements of the Community Development Block Grant Program;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Town of Silver City, New Mexico, that

1. The Town of Silver City is hereby authorized to prepare and submit a Community Development Block Grant application to the New Mexico Department of Finance and Administration/Local Government Division for a Street and Drainage Improvement Project on Alice, Bullard, Garcia and Texas Street; and
2. The Town Council directs and designates the Mayor as the Town of Silver City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the Town of Silver City's participation in the New Mexico Community Development Block Grant Program; and
3. The Town of Silver City officials and staff are directed to do any and all acts necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution; and
4. The application be for \$500,000.00 of grant funds to carry out a Street and Drainage Improvement Project on Alice, Bullard, Garcia and Texas Street in the Chihuahua Hill Neighborhood Area; and

5. That it further be stated that the Town of Silver City is committing \$75,000.00 from its general fund as a cash contribution toward the construction activities of this Street and Drainage Improvement Project on Alice, Bullard, Garcia and Texas Street in the Chihuahua Hill Neighborhood Area.
