A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION BY GRANT COUNTY TO THE NEW MEXICO JUVENILE JUSTICE ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR A GRANT TO PROVIDE SERVICES TO CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES

WHEREAS, the Grant County Commission intends to submit an application to the State of New Mexico Juvenile Justice Advisory Committee for a grant of funds necessary to provide services to meet the needs of the children, youth, and families of Grant County; and
