

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-25

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE FUNDING OF A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A VOCATIONAL CAREER CENTER AND SCHOOL

Sponsored by Mayor James R. Marshall.

WHEREAS, Senate Memorial 65 was introduced in the New Mexico State Legislature during its 2012 session which requested a feasibility study with regard to the establishment of a vocational career center and school in Grant County; and

WHEREAS, a committee has been formed comprising legislators, local elected officials, economic development organizations, Silver and Cobre Consolidated Schools, Western New Mexico University staff, and representatives of the business community to assist with the development of the feasibility study and to document the need for vocational education; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Silver City finds that vocational education is beneficial to the economic and social well being of the Town and Grant County, and supports the funding of the feasibility studies; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council believes that a vocational career center and school is necessary for providing economic opportunity to the youth of Grant County and the State of New Mexico, and lends it whole-hearted support for such an undertaking;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT *RESOLVED* that:

1. The Town of Silver City supports the establishment of a career and vocational center and school to be located in Grant County.
2. The Town of Silver City supports applications for funding made to governmental agencies within and outside of New Mexico.
