

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-29

A RESOLUTION FIXING THE COMPENSATION FOR TOWN MANAGER, AND FURTHER, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT BETWEEN THE TOWN AND ALEX C. BROWN.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Silver City finds that the current Town Manager/Finance Director, Alex C. Brown, has conducted his offices with great professionalism and efficiency, all to the benefit of the Town; and

WHEREAS, after review and consideration, the Town Council finds that executing a new employment contract with Alex C. Brown to serve as Town Manager, supplemental to his existing role as Finance Director, is in the best interest of the Town, and that authorizing the Mayor to negotiate and execute such contract with Alex C. Brown is appropriate; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-202 of the Municipal Code of the Town of Silver City requires that compensation of the Town Manager shall be fixed by either Ordinance or Resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Silver City to adopt the following:

That the compensation for Town Manager shall be fixed at One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) per annum, with provisions for discretionary annual increases not to exceed five percent (5%), the privilege of converting unused vacation time otherwise forfeited to deferred compensation, and such benefits regarding health insurance, leave, and retirement as may be negotiated; and

The Town Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to negotiate and execute a contract of employment with Alex C. Brown for the position of Town Manager.
