RESOLUTION 2006-51**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION WITH NEW MEXICO
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL UNDER THE TERMS OF THE
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, The Town of Silver City, Grant County, New Mexico, is a municipal corporation pursuant to the laws of the territory and the State of New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, Public meetings encouraging community participation and input were conducted for the 2007 CDBG Application; and

WHEREAS, Public notices provided reasonable preparation time to community residents of the date, time, location, and purpose of the public meetings and a display ad both in English and Spanish was published in the *Silver City Daily Press*, being a newspaper of general circulation in the area; and

WHEREAS, The Governing Body has identified a need to do a **Water System Improvement Project** for the Chihuahua Hill area; and

WHEREAS, The Water System Improvement Project will include waterline installation and replacement on Arizona, Pinos Altos, Bayard, San Vicente, Sonora, Gila, Chihuahua Streets; and

WHEREAS, The Water System Improvement Project meets the low/moderate income guidelines.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SILVER CITY THAT:

1. James Marshall is hereby authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the Town of Silver City with the New Mexico Community Development Council for a CDBG grant to do a Water System Improvement Project in the Chihuahua Hill area.
2. The above-named representative is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the New Mexico Community Development Council may reasonably request in connection with the application which is herein authorized to be filed, and is authorized to accept any offer of grant which may be tendered by the New Mexico Community Development Council.
