

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-15

**APPROVING AN APPLICATION TO NEW MEXICO FINANCE AUTHORITY
UNDER THE COLONIAS INFRASTRUCTURE FUND PROGRAM.**

WHEREAS, the Town of Silver City was designated a Colonias on August 1991; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bayard, the Town of Hurley, and the Village of Santa Clara are also Colonias designated areas; and

WHEREAS, the unincorporated areas of Rosedale, Pinos Altos, Arenas Valley, North Hurley, Fierro, Hanover, Vanadium, and Turnerville located in Grant County are Colonias designated areas; and

WHEREAS, the Grant County Water Commission agreed to apply for Colonias Infrastructure funds utilizing Silver City to take the lead and be fiscal agent for the application; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Silver City will be applying for Colonias funds for planning to develop a regional preliminary engineering report for a regional water system for the above mentioned communities; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Silver City assures and certifies that it will comply with the regulations, policies, guidelines, and requirements with respect to the acceptance and use of the Colonias Infrastructure Program; and

WHEREAS, it is the majority opinion of the Governing Body in and for the Town of Silver City that the proposed grant will be in the best interest of the residents of the communities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY FOR THE TOWN OF SILVER CITY, NEW MEXICO, that Mayor James R. Marshall of the Town of Silver City is hereby directed to prepare and submit an application on behalf of the Town of Silver City for a regional preliminary engineering report benefitting the above mentioned Colonias requesting funding assistance from the NMFA Colonias Infrastructure Fund.
