

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-34

**SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION TO NEW MEXICO FINANCE AUTHORITY
UNDER THE COLONIAS INFRASTRUCTURE FUND FOR STREET AND DRAINAGE
IMPROVEMENTS IN SILVER CITY, GRANT COUNTY.**

WHEREAS, Town of Silver City was designated a Colonia on August 1, 1991; and

WHEREAS, Town of Silver City is in need of **Street & Drainage Improvements**; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will be constructed on **College Avenue** from Cooper Street west to E Street; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will benefit low income individuals/families, local residents, public services and the university; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Silver City assures and certifies that it will comply with the regulations, policies, guidelines, loan and match requirements and any requirements with respect to the acceptance and use of the Colonias Infrastructure Program; and

WHEREAS, it is the majority opinion of the governing body in and for the Town of Silver City that the proposed grant will be in the best interest of the residents of the community;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Silver City that it endorses and supports an application for Fiscal Year 2016/2017 Colonias Infrastructure funding; and that

The Town Council directs the Town Manager to prepare and submit an application on behalf of the Town of Silver City for funding assistance from the New Mexico Finance Authority Colonias Infrastructure Fund for Street and Drainage Improvements on College Avenue from Cooper Street west to E Street. The Town Manager is designated to act in all matters in connection with this application, and to do all acts necessary to carry out the intent of the Resolution.
