

**RESOLUTION 2005-08**

**AUTHORIZING THE NAMING OF THE TOWN OF SILVER CITY'S  
WATER/SEWER UTILITIES BUILDING  
IN HONOR OF THE LATE CALISTRO "CAL" M. MUÑOZ**

**WHEREAS**, Calistro "Cal" M. Muñoz was a dedicated Town employee for more than 40 years, perhaps the longest-serving water/sewer employee in the Town's history; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Muñoz served under numerous Mayors, Councilors, Town Managers and Supervisors, retiring in 1999 as Water Foreman; and


**WHEREAS**, Mr. Muñoz was respected and recognized for his dedication and professionalism by all of his supervisors and fellow workers; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Muñoz on numerous occasions was cited for his expertise and assistance by engineering and construction firms doing water and/or sewer improvements to the Town's infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Muñoz was very well known for his willingness to be on call "24/7"—nights, weekends and holidays—to respond to emergencies at the Town's well fields, for water or sewer line breaks, and even for individual residential and commercial users of the Town's water and sewer systems.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SILVER CITY** hereby officially names the Town's Water/Sewer Utilities Building in honor of Calistro "Cal" M. Muñoz; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a dedication ceremony, including proper signage designating the **Calistro "Cal" M. Muñoz Water/Sewer Utilities Building** be scheduled for late Spring or early Summer 2005.
