

**TOWN OF SILVER CITY  
RESOLUTION 2005-38**

**FOR THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD MARCH 7, 2006**

Be it resolved by the Governing Body of the Town of Silver City that:

- A. A regular municipal election for the election of municipal officers shall be held on March 7, 2006. Polls will open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m.
- B. At the regular municipal election, persons shall be elected to fill the following elective offices:
  - 1. Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4—One Mayor for a two-year term.
  - 2. District 2—One Councilor for a two-year term.
  - 3. District 4—One Councilor for a two-year term.
  - 4. Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4—One Municipal Judge for a four-year term.
- C. Precincts are consolidated for the regular municipal election as follows:
  - 1. District 1      Precincts 14 and 15
  - 2. District 2      Precincts 12, 13 and 18
  - 3. District 3      Precincts 8, 17, 20, 21, 22 and 33
  - 4. District 4      Precincts 16, 19 and 32
- D. The following locations are designated as polling places for the conduct of the regular municipal election:
  - 1. Voters in District 1 shall vote at the Silver City Woman’s Club, 411 Silver Heights Blvd., Silver City, New Mexico 88061.
  - 2. Voters in District 2 shall vote at the Public Library, 515 West College Ave., Silver City, New Mexico 88061.
  - 3. Voters in District 3 shall vote at the Silver City Senior Center, 205 West Victoria St., Silver City, New Mexico 88061.
  - 4. Voters in District 4 shall vote at the Knights of Columbus, 1301 North Swan St., Silver City, New Mexico 88061.
- E. Absentee Voting.

Any qualified elector of the Town of Silver City shall obtain an application for an absentee ballot, only from the Office of the Municipal Clerk at City Hall, 101 West Broadway, Silver City, New Mexico. All applications for an absentee ballot must be completed and accepted by the Municipal Clerk prior to 5:00 p.m., March 3, 2006. After 5:00 p.m. on March 3, 2006, all unused absentee ballots will be publicly destroyed by the Municipal Clerk. The Municipal Clerk will accept completed absentee ballots delivered by mail, or in person by the voter casting the absentee ballot or by a member of the voter’s immediate family, until 7:00 p.m. on March 7, 2006.

Absentee ballots may be marked in person in the Office of the Municipal Clerk during the regular hours and days of business, beginning on Wednesday, February 8, 2006 and closing at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 3, 2006.

Absentee voting by machine will be conducted in the Office of the Municipal Clerk, during the regular hours and days of business, Monday through Friday, beginning on Wednesday, February 8, 2006 and closing at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 3, 2006.

- F. Persons desiring to register to vote at the regular municipal election must register with the Grant County Clerk not later than Tuesday, February 7, 2005 at 5:00 p.m., the date on which the County Clerk will close registration books.
- G. All Declarations of Candidacy shall be filed with the Municipal Clerk on Tuesday, January 10, 2006 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- H. The casting of votes by qualified municipal electors on March 7, 2006 shall be recorded on voting machines.
