

**RESOLUTION 2005-39**

**VACATING A PARTIAL PART OF BLACKHAWK AND TRAILS END  
AND ALL OF WOODCREST ROADS OF INDIAN HILLS SUBDIVISION,  
UNIT 4, N.M.P.M., GRANT COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, DECLARING  
THE PROPERTY NON-ESSENTIAL FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES  
AND TO BE UTILIZED AS RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY**

**WHEREAS**, the roads combined amount to a total of 2.17± acres and have been held in ownership by the Town since May 7, 2003 and have remained undeveloped; and

**WHEREAS**, there exists no developed roads within the proposed location and if roads were to be constructed they would have to meet Town standards; and

**WHEREAS**, the roads are located within the Town limits and are surrounded by single-family structures and therefore not viable for municipal purposes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Town of Silver City, New Mexico, that the above described roads be declared non-essential for municipal purposes and sold as real property.
